(Genesis 1:27)

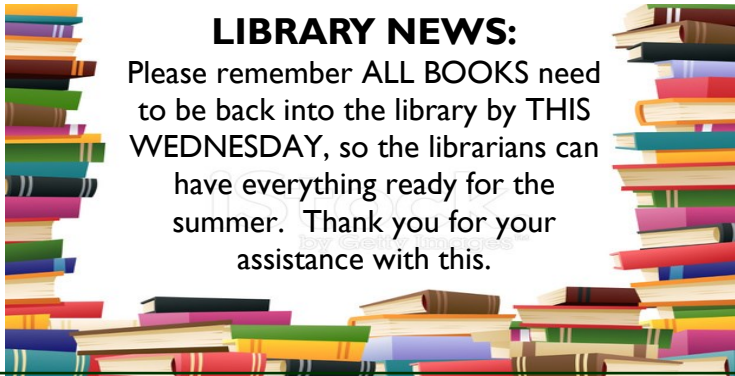

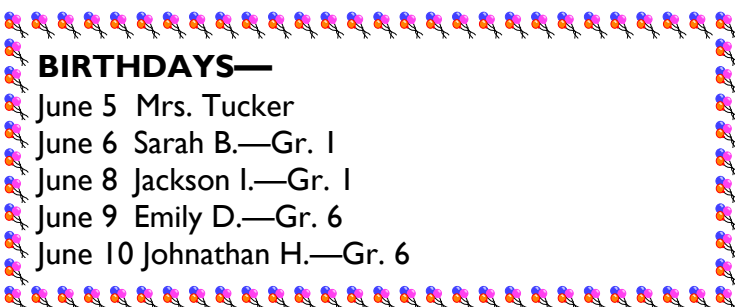
